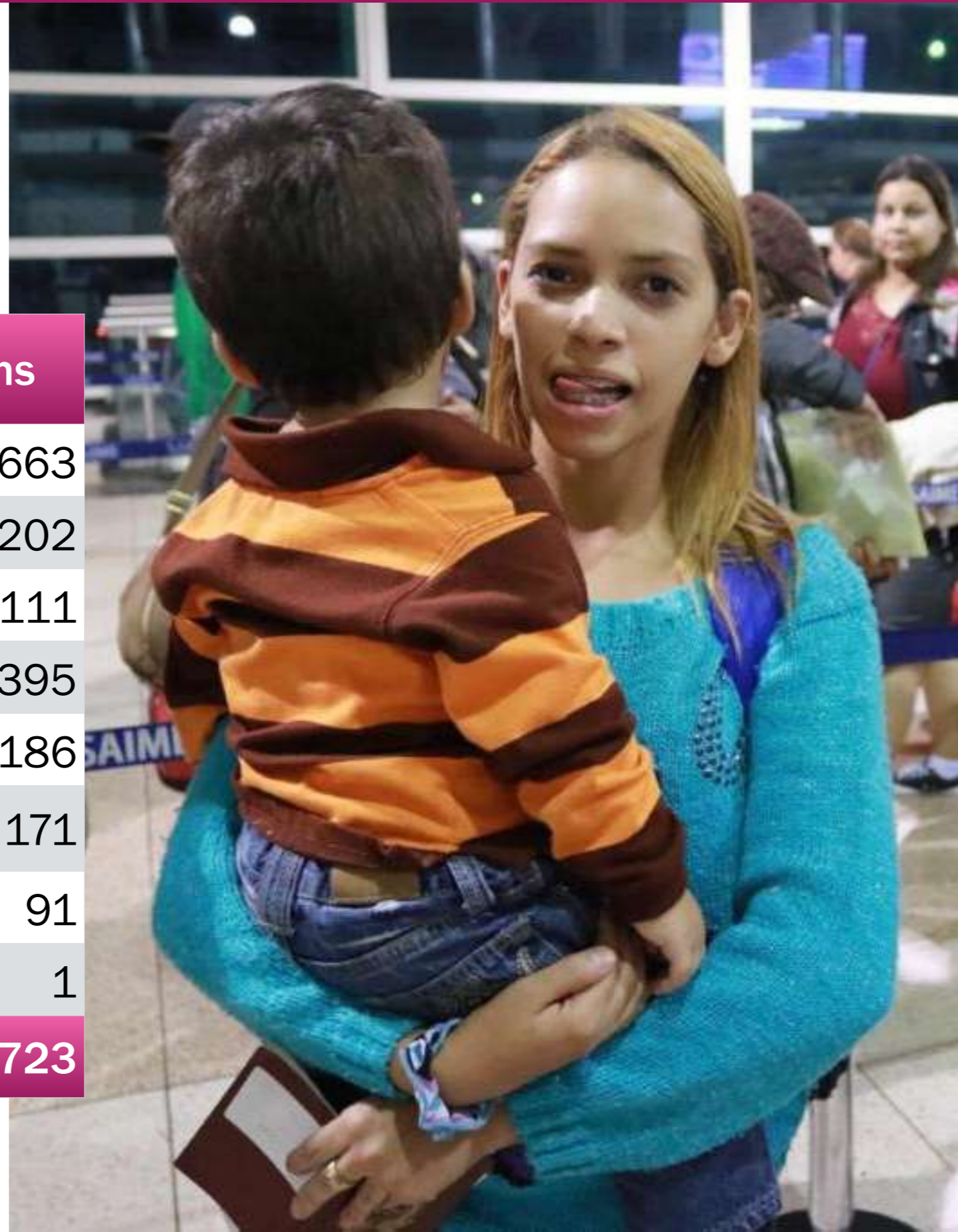

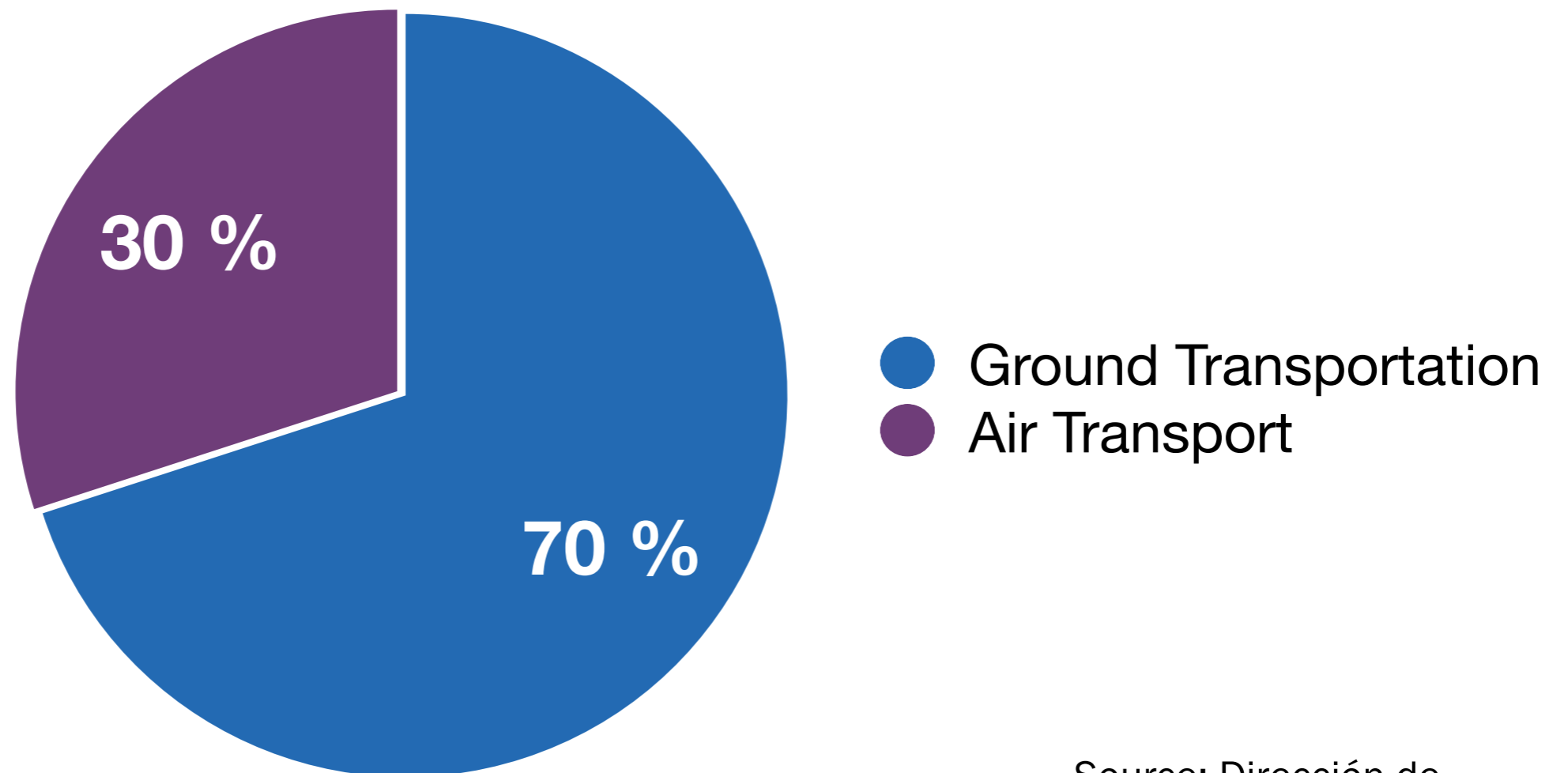

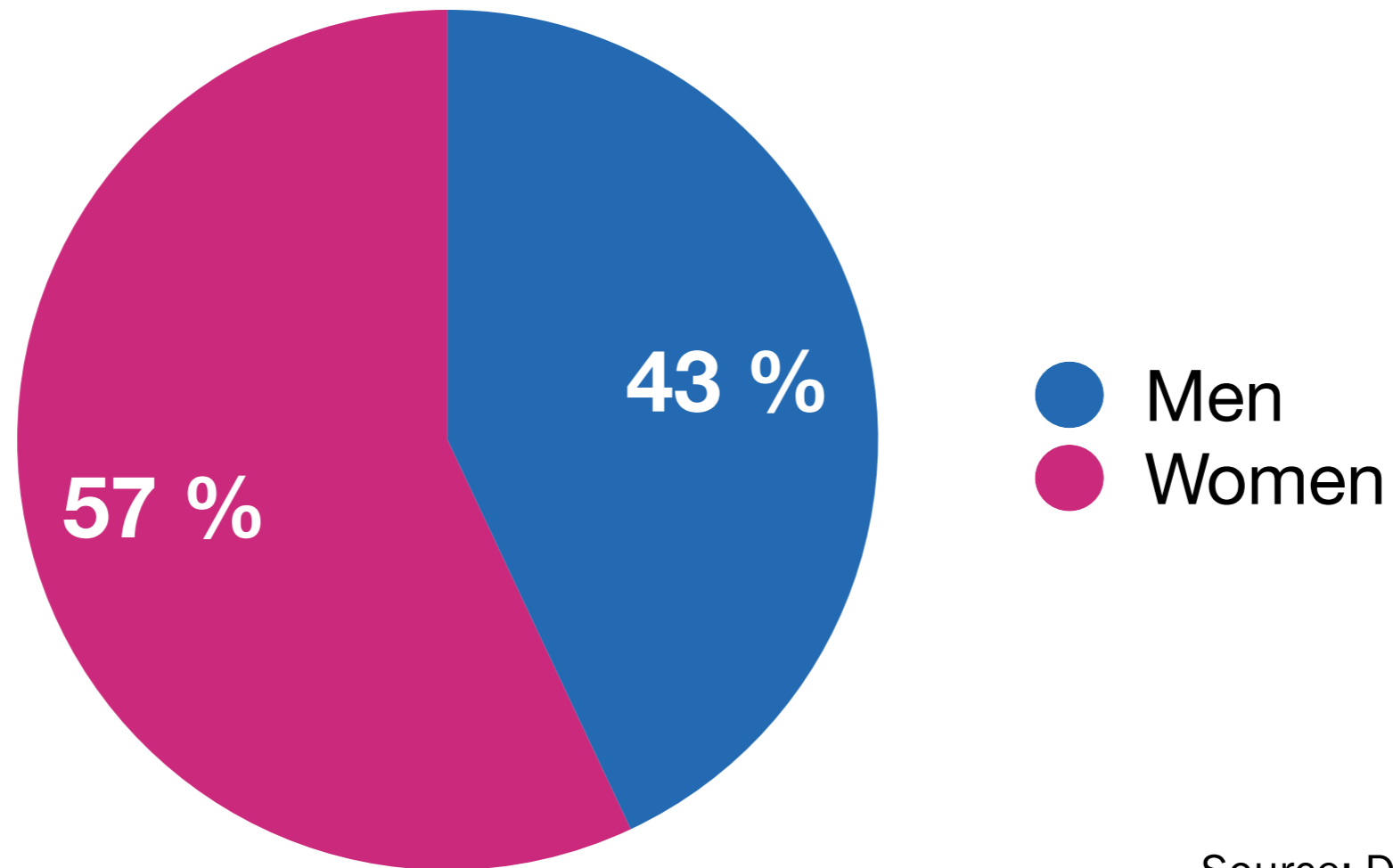

Distribution of returns by type of transport



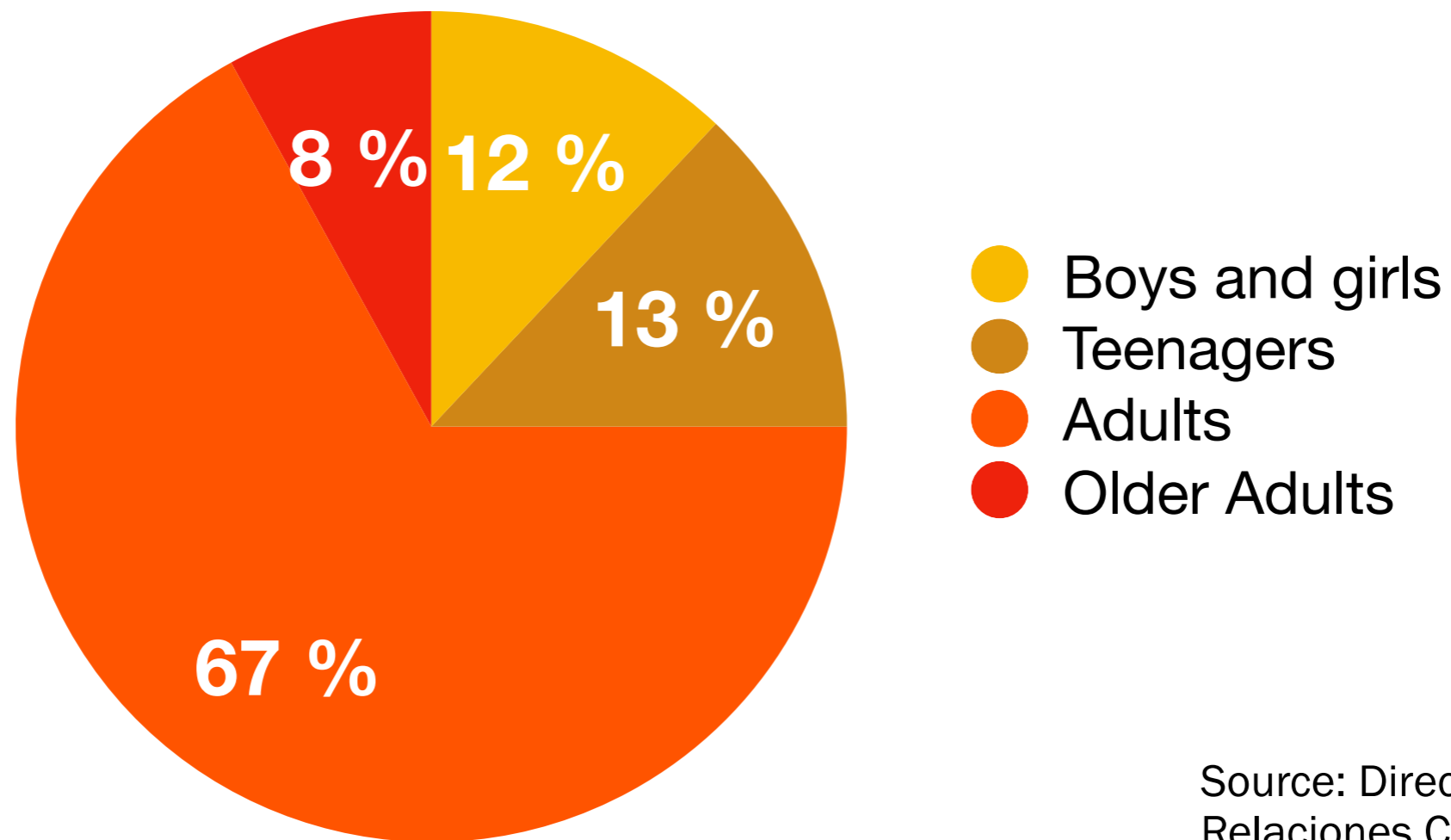

Three main reasons for return to Venezuela

62% of returnees identified the first cause of the return to the country economic problems and the inability to obtain decent employment in the countries to which they migrated.

50 % expressed as an additional reason of return the constant harassment in the host country, denouncing strong episodes of xenophobia, exploitation, labor mistreatment and social exclusion

19% said they were suffering from serious health problems.
