# Communiqué

The President of the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela, Nicolas Maduro Moros, on behalf of the Venezuelan government and people, rejoices on the occasion of the 34<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the establishment of diplomatic relations between Venezuela and Saint Kitts and Nevis.
