

The Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela rejects the warmongering remarks of the President of the Cooperative Republic of Guyana, Irfaan Ali, during a media show on Friday, 27 october, in the territory of the Guayana Esequiba

Following instructions from the U.S. Southern Command, which has ordered him to escalate his actions, President Ali has shown a behavior contrary to the commitments assumed in the Geneva Agreement of 1966, which sets the path to be followed for resolving the territorial controversy between Guyana and Venezuela.

Venezuela denounces, once again, the buy off of the entire Guyanese leadership by Exxon Mobil, a transnational corporation that designs plans to threaten and attack the Venezuelan people and that steals the resources that belong to them.

The Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela, in defense of its legitimate and historical rights over the Guayana Esequiba, urges Guyana to relinquish the war race, to assume diplomatic dialogue and to abandon illegal actions, contrary to the Geneva Agreement, which is the valid instrument for the settlement of the territorial dispute between both countries.
