# Communiqué

The Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela announces that, following diplomatic talks with the authorities of the United States of America, both governments have decided to reestablish diplomatic and consular relations.

The Bolivarian Government reaffirms its willingness to move forward into a new phase of constructive dialogue based on mutual respect, the sovereign equality of States, and cooperation between our peoples.

Venezuela expresses its confidence that this process will contribute to strengthening understanding and opening opportunities for a positive and mutually beneficial relationship. These relations ought to result in the social and economic happiness of the Venezuelan people.

This step is joined by the fruitful dialogue that Venezuelans are holding among themselves, aimed at strengthening coexistence, peace, and national understanding.

Finally, the Bolivarian Government recalls the words of our Liberator Simón Bolívar, who, from Angostura, in the context of the birth of the new Republic, expressed his desire to establish "relations of friendship and good understanding" with the Government of the United States of America.
