The Venezuelan people, along with the Government of the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela, hereby expresses its most heartfelt words of solidarity in the aftermath of the tropical storm Urduja (Kai-Tak), which occurred this last December 18th, 2017 in the Province of Biliran, Philippines and which left fifty-four persons dead and around twenty-three missing people, causing a deep sense of grief and sadness to its population.

The Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela conveys its deepest condolences to the Government of the Republic of Philippines, to its people and to the families of the victims amid such sensitive moments, while it reaffirms its full solidarity with our Philippine brothers.
