

Communiqué

The President of the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela, Nicolas Maduro Moros, on behalf of the Venezuelan People and Government, celebrates the recent agreements contained in the final declaration of the Vienna Summit on the Multinational Nuclear Agreement with Iran, in which the Foreign Ministers of the Islamic Republic of Iran, the United Kingdom, France, Russia, China and Germany met.

This Agreement, which outlines the development of the nuclear program of the Islamic Republic of Iran, is the culmination of twelve years of negotiations between the signatory countries, stressing that during its three years of implementation, all parties have repeatedly confirmed its correct application and good functioning through the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA), with the necessary practical measures by the remaining members of the Group 4 + 1 (United Kingdom, France, Russia, China and Germany) to offset the sanctions of the United States of America. The Bolivarian Government welcomes the prevalence of dialogue, peace and diplomacy, in contrast to other interventionist and unilateral measures that ignore international law with the purpose of subordinating the Peoples.

The Bolivarian Government recognizes the effort and respect for the implementation of the Joint Comprehensive Action Plan and encourages the International Community to defend this Agreement under the framework of Resolution No. 2233 of the UN Security Council, for the benefit of multilateralism, world peace and development to which the noble Iranian people are entitled.

The Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela, in accordance with its principle of Diplomacy of Peace, reiterates once again its deep friendship and solidarity with the People and the Government of the Islamic Republic of Iran.
